> "Family means a Covernment servant's wife/husband. children and other persons residing with and wholly dependent upon him/her. A husband/wife/child/ parent having an independent source of income is not treated as a member belonging to the family of a Government servant except when he is in receipt only of a gross pension (including temporary increase in pension and pension equivalent of death-cum-retirement gratuity or other retirement benefits) not exceeding Rs. 100/- per month."

2. In so far as the persons serving in Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
