The undersigned is directed to invite reference to this Ministry Office Memorandum No.F.2(37)-E.II(B)/64, dated the 27th November 1965, on the subject indicated above and to say that the President has been pleased to decide - that the following further amendment shall be made therein namely:-

For the existing clause (iii) of sub-para (b) of para 4, the following shall be substituted namely -

" (iii) A Government servant debarred from allotment of Government accommodation due to unauthorised subletting, or for other breaches of rules, but excluding these covered by clause (b)(i) above, will be eligible for house rent allowance during the period of such debarment, subject to the fulfilment of the usual conditions except that the condition that he must have applied for but not provided with Government accommodation will not be enforced in his case."
