OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Transfer of posts within an organisation - application  
of ban orders.

.....  
The undersigned is directed to say that instances have come to notice when a post sanctioned for a specific purpose in an organisation is diverted for another purpose at the same or different station and/or utilised as a standby to accommodate an officer awaiting posting orders or to make use of the services of an officer for some special item of work etc. Such diversion of posts obviously leads to the conclusion that the purpose for which the post was originally created has ceased to exist and diversion is effected to cope with some new item of work, notwithstanding the fact that such arrangement is within the same cadre/organisation and/or at the same or different stations. It has been decided that such cases of diversion/transfer/adjustment of posts would amount to creating new posts and therefore, attract the ban orders at present in force on creation of fresh posts-wide this Ministry's O.M.NO. F.14(4)-E(Coord)/77 dated 27th May, 1977 - and prior clearance should be obtained at the appropriate level before resorting to such a practice.
