The Officers would have option to purchase Indian Newspaper of their choice. The reimbursement respect of the Newspapers may be made by the respective Ministries/Departments of the Officers on production of Bill/Cash Memo by the concerned Officer but in respect of Secretary/Addl.Secretary level officers, the bills can be paid directly by the Government to the newspaper if so desired by the Officer. The Officers will have the option to either return the old newspapers or to make a deduction from the re-imbursement bi11 such Newspapers. No reimbursement in respect retaining of Magazines/Periodicals may, however, be allowed these may not be permitted on individual basis but could be purchased by the Library of the Department supplied to the Officers on circulatory basis.
