OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject :- Applicability of the orders contained in the Ministry of Finance Office Memorandum No.F.10(24)-E.III/60, dated the 4th May, 1961 to appointments made against posts temporarily excluded from the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service on the personal staff of Ministers.


The undersigned is directed to refer to the orders contained in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.10(24)-E.III/60, dated the 4th May, 1961 and to say that after a careful examination of the question of the applicability of the orders referred to above to appointments against temporarily excluded posts of the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service on the personal staff of Ministers, the President has been pleased to decide that the appointment of officers of the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service, not approved for appointment to Grade I of that Service, as 1st P.As. to Ministers by temporarily excluding the posts should not be treated as "deputation" and their terms in such temporarily excluded posts should not be governed by this Ministry's orders of 4th May, 1961.

2. The President has also been pleased to decide that such unapproved officers, while holding the temporarily excluded posts, should get, in addition to their own grade pay, the difference between what they would have got under the normal rules from time to time had they been promoted to Grade I of Central Sectt. Stenographers' Service, and their own grade pay from time to time, as special pay, subject, however, to the condition that this special pay should in no case exceed 25% of the grade pay in Grade II of the C.S.S.S.

3. This decision does not, however, affect the existing position in regard to regulation of pay of officers of the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service on their appointment to ex-cadre posts of Assistant Private Secretary to Minister or Private Secretary to Deputy Minister.

4. Past cases in which Pay might have been fixed in any manner other than the one indicated in these orders should be reviewed in the light of these orders. Past payments will not however, be readjusted.
