

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Enhancement in the rate of qualification pay from Rs.15/- to Rs.30/- per month consequent upon the revision of scales of pay on the recommendations of the 4th Central Pay Commission.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's O.M. No. 7(56)-E.III(A)/78 dated 25.9.1981 regarding grant of qualification pay of Rs.15/- per month to the Auditors in the Indian Audit & Accounts Department and certain other organised Accounts Cadres and to the Clerks Gr.II in the Railway Accounts Department on passing Departmental Examination and to say that Staff Side, National Council (JCM) raised a demand regarding revision of rate of qualification pay consequent upon implementation of revised scales of pay based on the recommendations of the Fourth Central Pay Commission and certain other allied matters. These matters have been under consideration of the Government for some time past. The President has now been pleased to decide that the rate of qualification pay may be enhanced from Rs.15/- p.m. to Rs. 30/- p.m. with effect from the date an individual elects to draw pay in the CCS(RP) Rules, 1986.

2. The qualification pay will be treated as part of pay for the purpose of fixation of pay on promotion to the higher post.
3. As regards DA/ADA already drawn on the qualification pay prior to the date of individual's adoption of revised scale, it has been decided that the payment so made be regularised.
4. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
