OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revision of pay-scales at senior levels.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.27-J.S.(Per)/65 dated 24.8.1965 wherein revised scales of pay were sanctioned for posts of Joint Secretaries and above including equivalent posts. It has been brought to this Ministry's notice that there are certain isolated posts under the Central Government which carry other pay-scales going beyond Rs.2250/-, e.g.:

- Rs.2000-100-2500
- Rs.2250-125-2500
- Rs.2250-125-2750
- Rs.2500-125-2750
- Rs.2750-125-3000

2. In most such cases it may be necessary to carry out consequential adjustments in the existing pay scales after reviewing each case on merit, though not necessarily from 1.9.1965. For this purpose, the Ministry of Home Affairs etc. are requested to furnish full particulars of the posts in

in Government departments, where pay is being drawn in the above scales or other scales, if any, carrying a maximum higher than Rs. 2250. It may also be indicated whether the existing pay-scale is personal to the incumbent or is sanctioned for the post. In the cases of posts carrying the scale of Rs. 2000-2500, the details of the pay drawn by existing incumbents, the date of increment etc. may also be given.

3. The information as in para 2 above may kindly be furnished through the associated Financial Adviser concerned.
