

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Ban on revision of pay scales

The undersigned is directed to make a reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.5(35)-E.III(A)/66 dated the 22nd August, 1970 extending the operation of the existing ban on salary structures at any level for a further period upto 30th June, 1971. While considering the question of grant of interim relief to Central Government employees on the basis of the recommendations of the Third Pay Commission, the Cabinet after taking into account the additional strain which the expenditure on above account will have on the budgetary position of Government, have decided, inter alia as a measure of economy that there should be a total ban on any upgradation or revision of pay scales till such time as the final recommendations of the Third Pay Commission are received and considered by the Government. Ministries/Departments etc. are requested, therefore, to take note of the above decision for due compliance.
