OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Exercise of option under the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1973 - Extension of time limit.

.....

The undersigned is directed to say that under rule 6 of the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1973, published in Part II - Section 3 - Subsection (i) of Gazette of India extraordinary dated 13.11.73 (Ministry of Finance Notification No.GSR. 99(E) dated 13.11.73), the option to come over to the revised scales or to retain the existing scales has to be exercised within three months of the date of publication of those Rules or where an existing scale is revised by an order made subsequent to that date, within three months of the date of such order. On a suggestion made by the Staff Side of the National Council set up under the scheme of Joint Consultative Machinery, it has been agreed to extend the date by which the employees were required to exercise their options. The President is accordingly pleased to decide that the time-limit for the exercise of option prescribed in rule 6 aforesaid shall be extended by two months in respect of services/posts the revised pay scales of which have been notified upto the end of January 1974, i.e. those included in the Ministry of Finance Notifications given below:-

- i) G.S.R. 499(E) dated 13.11.73
- ii) G.S.R. 517(E) dated 10.12.73
- iii) G.S.R. 528(E) dated 17.12.73
- iv) G.S.R. 536(E) dated 24.12.73
- v) G.S.R. 542(E) dated 31.12.73
- vi) G.S.R. 10(E) dated 11.1.74
- vii) G.S.R. 20(E) dated 25.1.74

2. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders issue after consultation with the Cr.&.A.G. of India.
