OFFICE MEMORANDUM.

Subject:- TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE
OF SCIENTISTS.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.13(47)-E.III/58, dated the 18th July, 1959 as partially modified by this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.13(22)-Est.III/59, dated the 16th June, 1960 on the subject mentioned above.

2. The scheme of 'Merit promotions and advance increments' envisaged in the orders quoted above provide for the formation of a High Level Selection Board for the selection of personnel fit for Merit promotions and advance increments. The orders also provide that the Merit promotions as well as advance increments may be sanctioned by the Secretary of the Ministry concerned or such other authority to whom he may delegate the powers.

3. It is clarified that the intention is that once the selection of personnel fit for Merit promotion and advance increments has been made by the High Level Selection Board and recommended by the Heads of the Scientific Organisations concerned, the recommendations should not be varied, unless strong reasons exist for doing so. This will apply only in respect of those Institutes or Scientific Organisations where the scheme of 'Merit promotions and advance increments' has been introduced, on the basis of the orders issued by this Ministry.
