OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Allocation of posts of Technical/Research/Economic Assistants etc., in the scale of Rs.160-10-330 and Rs.250-10-300-15-450-25/2-500.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.1(4)-EIII/50 dated the 14th June, 1950 (copy enclosed) in which it has been laid down that when the higher grade posts are filled by promotion from the lower grades the selection should ordinarily be confined to such persons only as have rendered not less than four years service in the lower grade and are not drawing pay less than Rs.200/- . The limit of Rs.200/- in the prescribed scale should be taken as Rs.250/- in the revised scale of Rs.210-425.

Subject:- Allocation of posts of Technical/Research/Economic Assistants etc., in the scales of Rs.160-10-330 and Rs.250-10-300-15-450-25/2-500.

The undersigned is directed to say that the scales of Rs.160-10-300 and of Rs.250-10-300-15-450-25/2-500 have been prescribed on the basis of the recommendations of the Central Pay Commission for the posts of Research/Economic/Technical Assistants, etc. under various Ministries of the Government of India. The higher grade is intended only for a small percentage of posts, the exact figure being decided in each case in consultation with this Ministry and the Ministry of Home Affairs. It has been decided in consultation with the Ministry of Home Affairs and in the interests of uniformity that when the higher grade posts are filled by promotion from the lower grade, selection should ordinarily be confined to such persons only as have rendered not less than 4 years' service in the lower grade of Research/Economic/Technical Assistants etc. and are not drawing pay less than Rs.200.

These orders will take effect from the date of this Office Memorandum, and any earlier appointments will not be disturbed.
